REDEEMER OSHC VACATION CARE INFORMATION

PROGRAM:

Our program consists of themed days which all involve indoor and outdoor play experiences. All days provide children with options for craft creations, language activities, physical challenges, social games, and plenty of child-led, spontaneous play. Fostering children's social and emotional development is as important to us as supporting their cognitive and physical development, so we love to encourage their creative and imaginative learning with free play opportunities.

BOOKINGS:

All bookings must be made by parents/guardians via the Xplor app. You will not receive any confirmations for standard Vacation Care days but will be able to see your bookings in the app's calendar tab instantly, as noted by a small orange dot on relevant days. Places in additional activities, such as incursions and excursions, will be confirmed via email once forms are received by the service.

INCURSIONS & EXCURSIONS:

A completed authorisation form must be returned to the service with parent/guardian signature prior to all incursions and excursions. Phone, email or verbal permission are not suitable and will not be accepted in replacement of a signed authorisation form.

FOOD & DRINK:

Our program allows for three food breaks (fruit snack at 9.30am, lunch at 12.00pm, optional afternoon tea at 3.00pm). **Our service now provides fruit and vegetable platters for both morning and afternoon tea, as well as an afternoon snack, but lunch still needs to be provided by families.** Please note we are unable to reheat or refrigerate food. A water bottle is also essential for all days.

ESSENTIALS:

Enclosed shoes, a wide-brimmed hat (**no caps**), and clothing that covers shoulders and upper arms are a must. Children without may be unable to participate in certain activities at the discretion of educators. **If attending BCLS, please also bring a basic pencil case and stationery items.**

PERSONAL ITEMS:

Please label all items, including clothing. **Personal devices, including phones, cameras, smart watches and music devices are not permitted and will be removed from children.** We strongly discourage children from bringing toys or games from home, and accept no responsibility for any damage, loss, or inappropriate use.

SESSIONS & FEES:

We offer four sessions for Vacation Care: 11hr with or without BCLS from 7.00am to 6.00pm, or 9hr with or without BCLS from 8.30am to 5.30pm. Standard session fees are \$73.00/day in 2025 or \$76.00/day in 2026. Bookings **made after 28 November for 2025 or after 19 December for 2026** will incur additional admin fees of \$5.00 per day. Sessions with BCLS incur an incursion fee of \$5.00.

- Your child may only attend within booked session hours. Children booked for the 9hr session who attend outside of session time will be moved to the 11hr session with a \$10.00 fee charged.
- Children collected after 6.00pm will be charged \$20.00 at 6.00pm and \$5.00 per additional 5 minutes thereafter.
- Failure to sign children in or out correctly is a breach of CCS obligations and will also incur additional admin fees of \$5.00 per child.
- Hats may be provided to children that do not have an appropriate hat (ie: no hat or cap only) at an additional fee of \$15.00 per hat.

7 days' notice is required for cancellations, or full fees will be charged. Absences before your child's first attendance or after your child's last attendance may result in CCS being revoked for these bookings, in which case full fees must be settled by the family. **If absent for your final day of VAC, please aim to re-attend within 12 weeks of your child's last physical attendance to avoid incurring a later debt.**

REDEEMER OSHC VACATION CARE SCHEDULED WORKS INFORMATION

Over the Summer 2025/2026 period, there are several construction projects scheduled to be completed across the Redeemer campus.

All efforts have been made to ensure that these projects will have minimal impact on our program, but there will be some impact to the maximum number of children we are able to accommodate during the summer holidays and to some play areas and collection zones.

Risk assessments have been prepared for all works and are available for families to view should you wish.

PREP/ONE CONSTRUCTION:

Our Prep/One playground is being redesigned and rebuilt for 2026. While this construction occurs, we will have no access to the Prep/One playground or classroom areas. Alternative access routes to the north side of campus will be via the JS oval. This construction (in conjunction with the 5/6 construction and JB renovations) will also involve the closure of Carpark 3.

5/6 BUILDING CONSTRUCTION:

A brand-new building is being constructed in replacement of the JA and JW areas on the east side of the JS playground. While this construction occurs, we will have no access to the area east of the JS playground, from our MPC to JG blocks. This construction (in conjunction with Prep/One construction and JB renovations) will also involve the closure of Carpark 3.

JB RENOVATIONS:

Interior renovations are being completed in the JB classrooms (MPC classrooms). While these renovations occur, we will have no access to the JB classroom areas or east side access to the MPC. Alternative access is still available to the north and west of the MPC. This is expected to have minimal impact to our service operation except for some possible noise pollution during early renovations. These renovations (in conjunction with the Prep/One and 5/6 constructions) will also involve the closure of Carpark 3.

DEMOUNTABLE INSTALLATION:

The installation of several demountable buildings will be occurring around the KCA area. This is expected to have very minimal to no impact on our service operation.

INSURANCE REPAIRS:

Minor insurance repairs after Cyclone Alfred are being completed across campus. This will involve interior repairs and updates to the Chapel, KCA, MH classrooms, JS Library, and MPC areas, most of which will take only 1-5 days in each area. Our service will communicate with the college maintenance team in regard to where these insurance repairs are taking place and alternative areas for our service to access during these days if required.

EXTERNAL CLEANING:

During the summer holidays, external cleaning of some buildings will also occur across campus. This is expected to have very minimal impact on our service operation and will be designed to occur at times/days that we are not using particular areas of campus.
